As we enter Advent, and a new church year begins on December 3rd, I am conscious of the conflicts, the hardships, and the suffering with which the old year has ended.

Many of us are currently grieving for family or friends who have died during the year. Others I know are suffering from recent medical diagnoses, or are wrestling with the ongoing impact of surgeries and treatments.

The social cohesion of our community has been pushed to the limit by the cost-of-living crisis, as the recent discussion about rates in the Upper Lachlan Shire has revealed deep divisions and made poor behaviour commonplace. Neighbour has turned against neighbour, and words of hatred and distrust pervade Facebook, coffee conversations and the local paper.

Meanwhile, the failure of the recent referendum seems to have been the permission some needed to let loose their racial hatreds once more. Indeed, a recent report in the paper revealed that people had booed an Acknowledgement of Country at a recent community forum. One wonders how such actions can be reconciled with God's vision of "loving our neighbour as ourselves," not to mention common respect and decency.

But then, perhaps this is not surprising, given the state of the world. The unprovoked murder and kidnapping of Israeli children, women and men in their homes by Hamas has revealed the spectre of the Holocaust and the reality of anti-Semitism still haunting the world. Meanwhile, the deaths of thousands of civilians on the Gaza strip have left many of us feeling helpless, and undermined all narratives of what makes a 'just war'.

For Christians, these events in the Middle East also provoke us to reflect on our own history, and the ways our churches continue to spread both anti-Semitic and Islamophobic narratives. Perhaps now, more than ever, we in the Church need to be reminded that our salvation is not secured by our own deeds or righteousness, but by the faithfulness of a first-century Palestinian Jew, born into poverty in Bethlehem, who loved briefly, died violently, and rose unexpectedly for all the world.

This Advent, therefore, we will join together to remember and anticipate the arrival of the God who is with us in both light and darkness. Making use of resources from *Illustrated Ministry*, we will have the opportunity to explore this theme in depth throughout December, in both out worship and our personal devotions, so that come Christmas Day, we who have dwelt in the land of deep darkness may come to see the light of Christ shining in our world, even today.
